

Materials and tools needed for making lace-up shoes up to size 41:

Cowhide leather 2mm thick, Veg-Tan, natural or dyed	0,2 sq.metres
Leather strap, 2,7 cm wide	1,50 m
Rubber or plastic sheet for soles, cutout 26x29 cm	1 pc
Shoe adhesive (for leather and plastic / rubber)	100 ml
Alcohol baised dye (or acrylic dye)	100 ml
Round gum 3 mm or flat gum, if using	1 m
Folding knife	1 pc
Softening of the footstep 20x28 cm - optional	1 pc
Insole material (flat) size 25x30 cm - optional	1 pc
Round punch 3 mm or punching pliers – needed if you will use round hat gum	1 pc
Wings-divider or fork with a 6 mm pitch	1 pc
Punch 1 mm	1 pc
Awl simple	1 pc
Mallet	1 pc
Wooden or plastic board	1 pc
Saddlery needles - blunt	2 pcs
Waxed polyester thread	15 m
Scissors for cutting the leather	1 pc
Flat brush	2 pcs
Sandpaper 40	1 pc
Long ruler	1 pc
Triangular ruler	1 pc
Dubbin or liquid wax	1 pc
