

Materials and tools needed for making sandals up to size 41:

- 0,1 sq. metres of 2 mm thick natural veg-tan leather
- 1,5 m of leather strip 1 - 1,4 cm wide (from the 2 mm veg-tan cowhide)
- 0,5 m of leather strip 1 cm wide (from the 2 mm veg-tan cowhide)
- 0,5 m of leather strip 2 or 3 cm wide (from the 2 mm veg-tan cowhide, thickness depending on the desired design)
- Rubber sheet of soles, 3 - 4 mm thick, cutout 26x29 cm (black or brown)
- 100 ml can of shoe glue
- 100 ml alcohol-based dye
- 2 pcs of buckles or special rivets to attach the sandals to the feet
- a piece of waxed polyester thread 0,8 - 1 mm thick (2-5 metres is enough)
- dubbin or beeswax balm
- folding knife
- round punch 4 mm or punching pliers
- carving chisel straight, 12 mm
- rubber mallet
- 1 pad
- saddlery blunt needle, 6-8 cms long,
- professional scissors with micro-serrations
- sandpaper 60
- flat painting brush, 2 pcs
- long ruler
- triangular ruler
